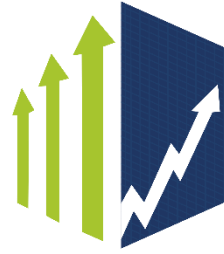

Executive Summary

- ❑ An opinion poll carried out by Global InfoAnalytics shows that approximately 52% of Ghanaians oppose to Ghana taking part in military action to restore democracy in Niger compared to 38% who support the move and 10% have no opinion.
- ❑ The poll also shows that Ghanaians by majority of 53% to 36% would urge parliament not to approve Ghana's participation in the invasion of Niger.
- ❑ However, the poll also shows that 84% of Ghanaians are concerned about recent coup d'état in West Africa, while 16% are not concerned with the development.
- ❑ The poll found nearly 76% of Ghanaians sharing the view that the coups have been occasioned by bad governance in those countries, 17% do not share this view and 7% have no opinion.
- ❑ On the question of whether they believe that military coups are durable solution to bad governance in Africa, nearly half of Ghanaians believe it is a solution to bad governance. The poll shows 49% of Ghanaian think coups are durable solution to bad governance, while 43% disagree and 8% have no opinion.
- ❑ 30% of Ghanaians say they have witnessed significant price increases in a number of essential commodities since the crisis began. 25% have seen some level of prices increases, while 26% have seen little changes. 7% have not seen any price changes and another 13% could not tell if prices have changed as a result.
- ❑ The poll which was carried out between 18-19 August sampled 1,618 respondents and has 95% confidence level and 2.4% margin of error. The samples were administered in all the 16 regions



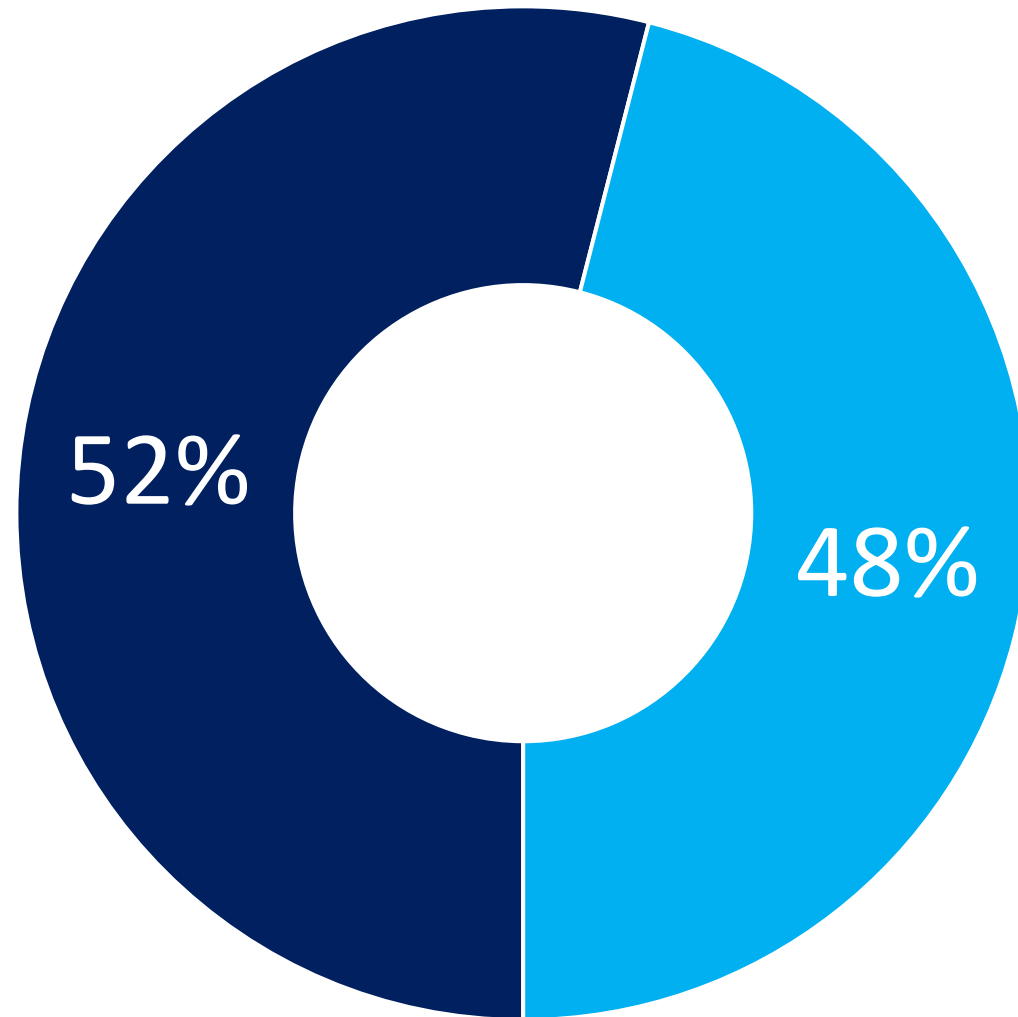

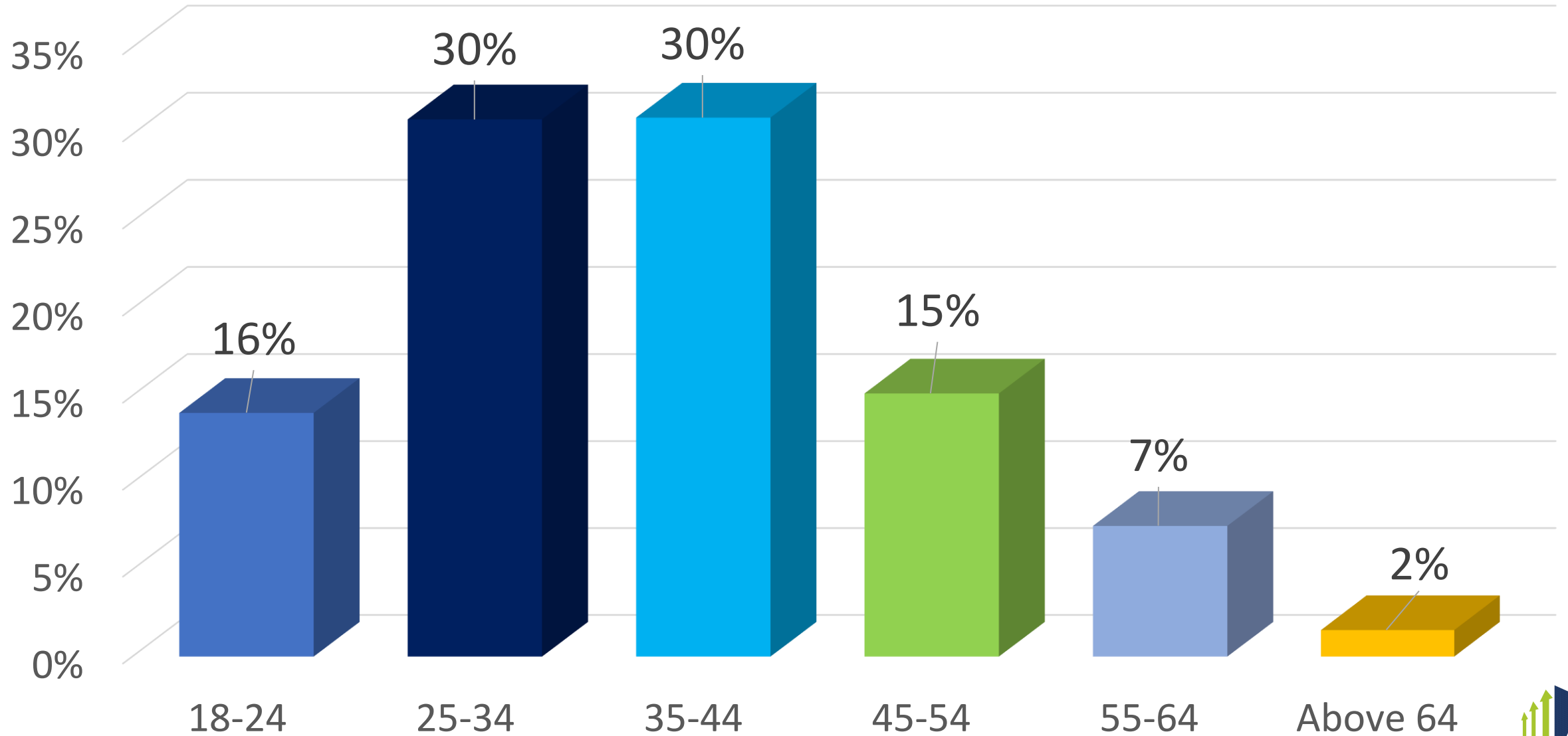

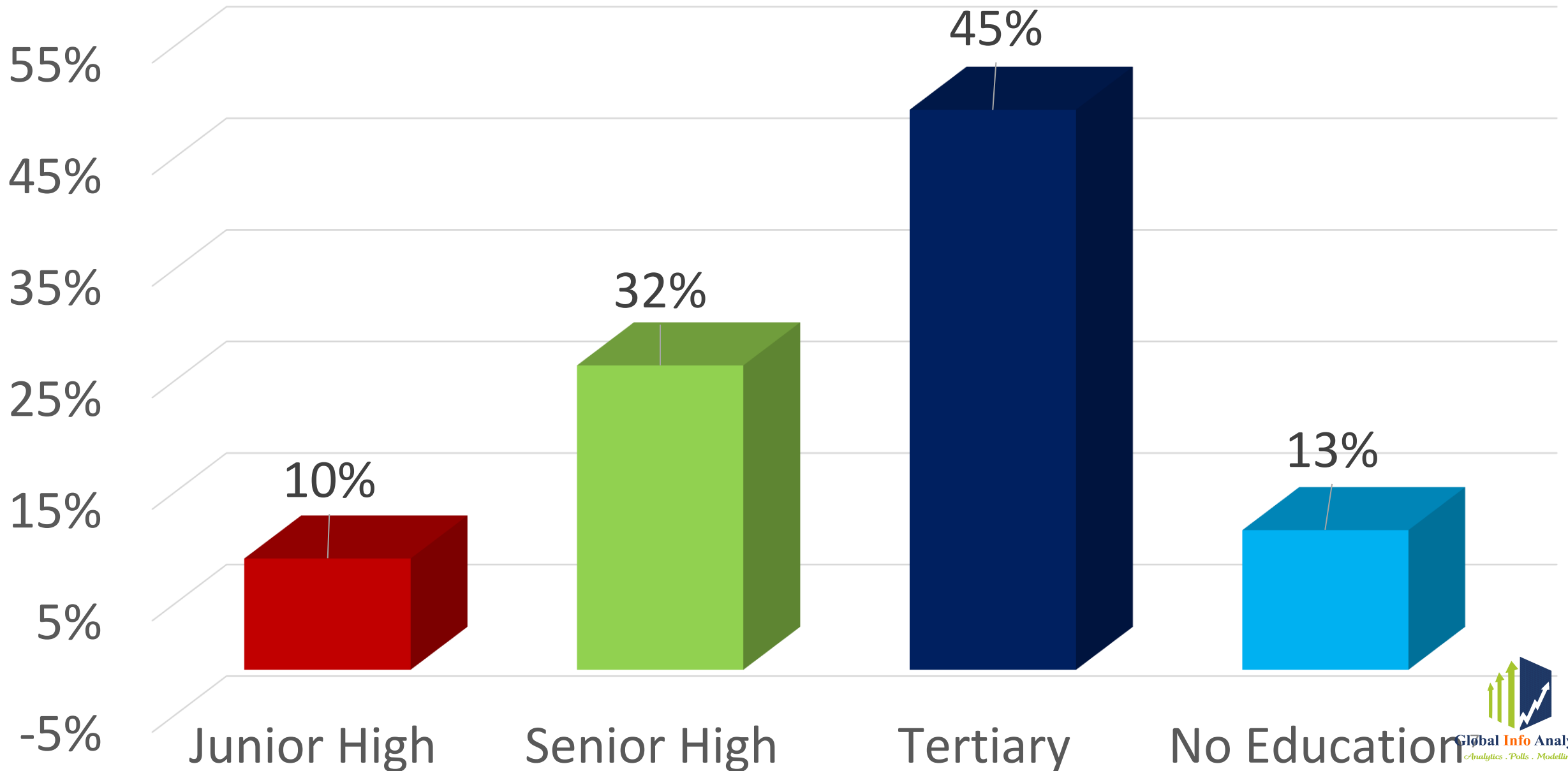

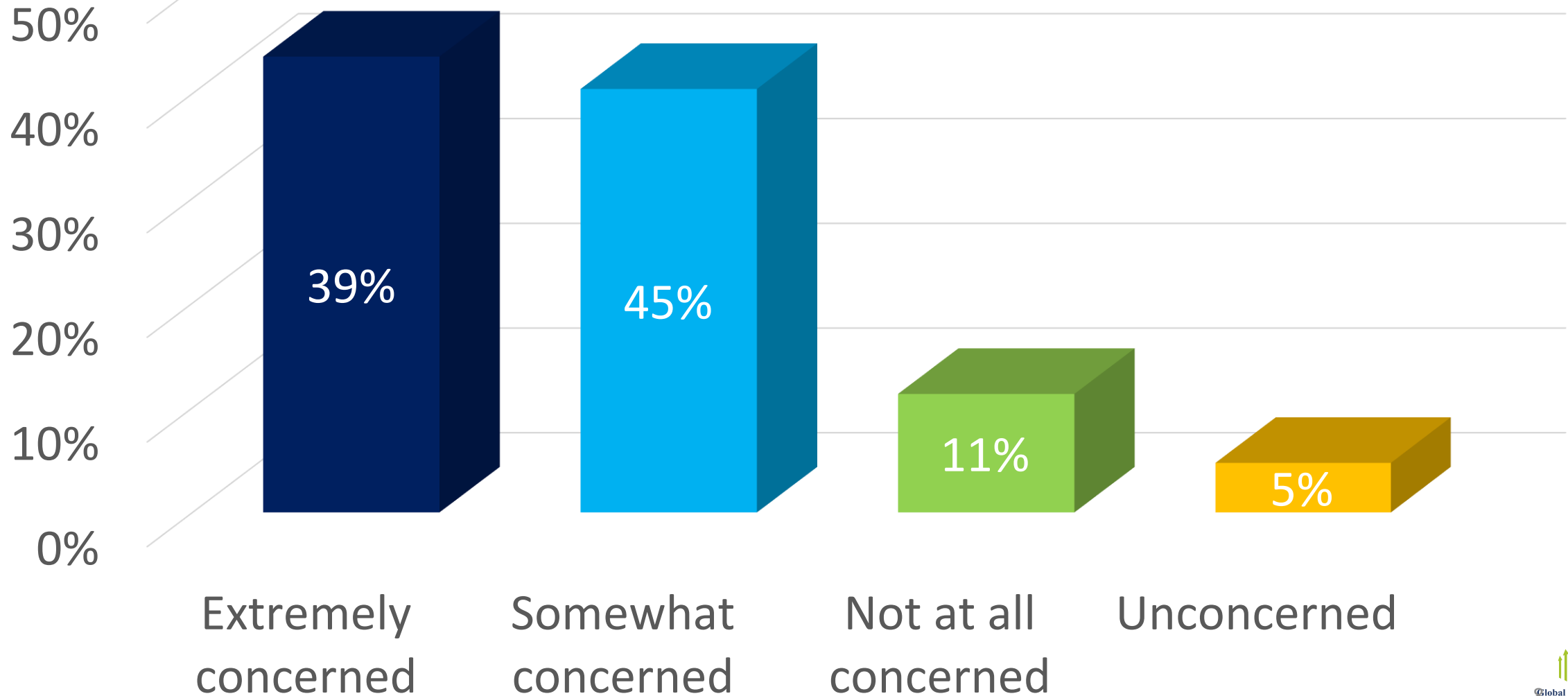

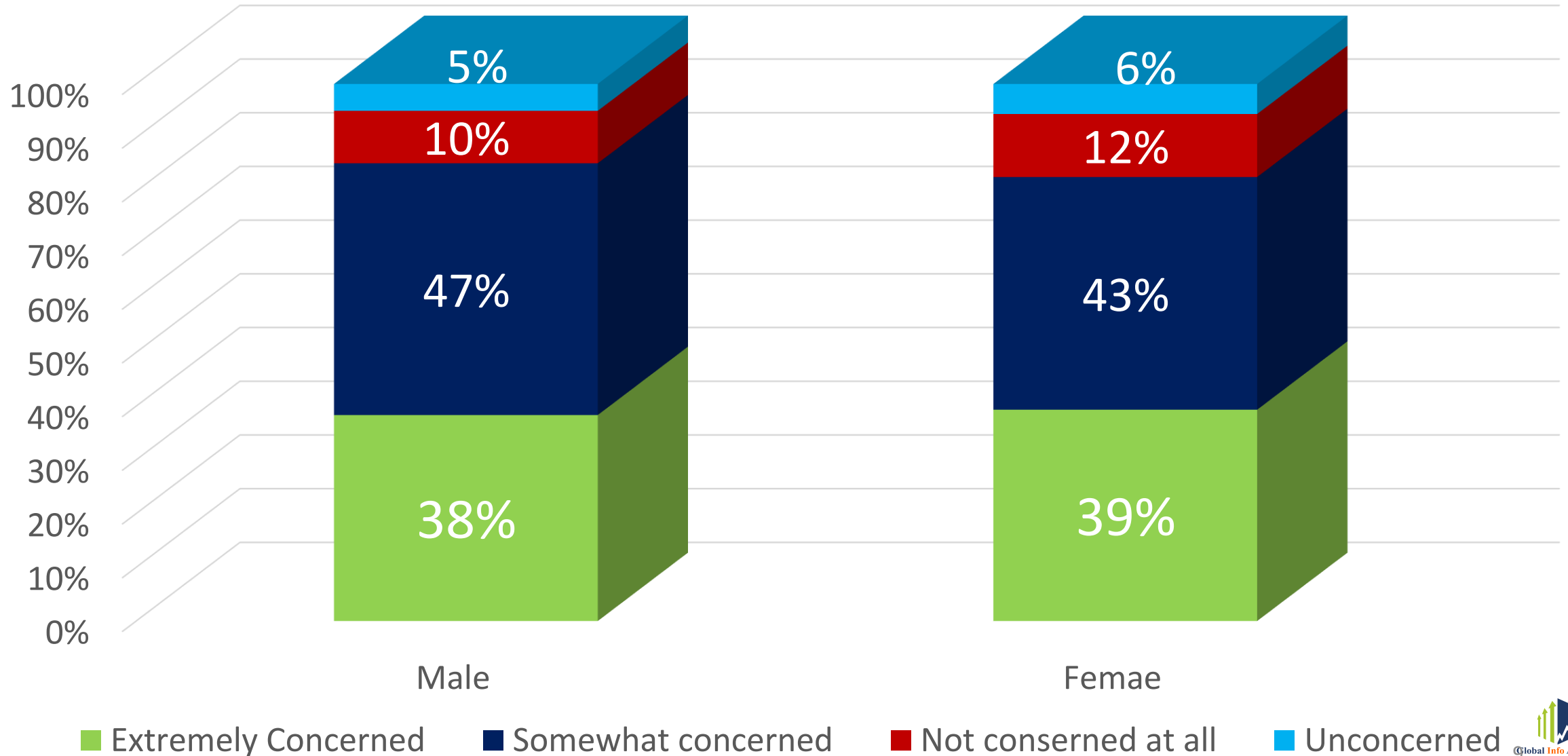

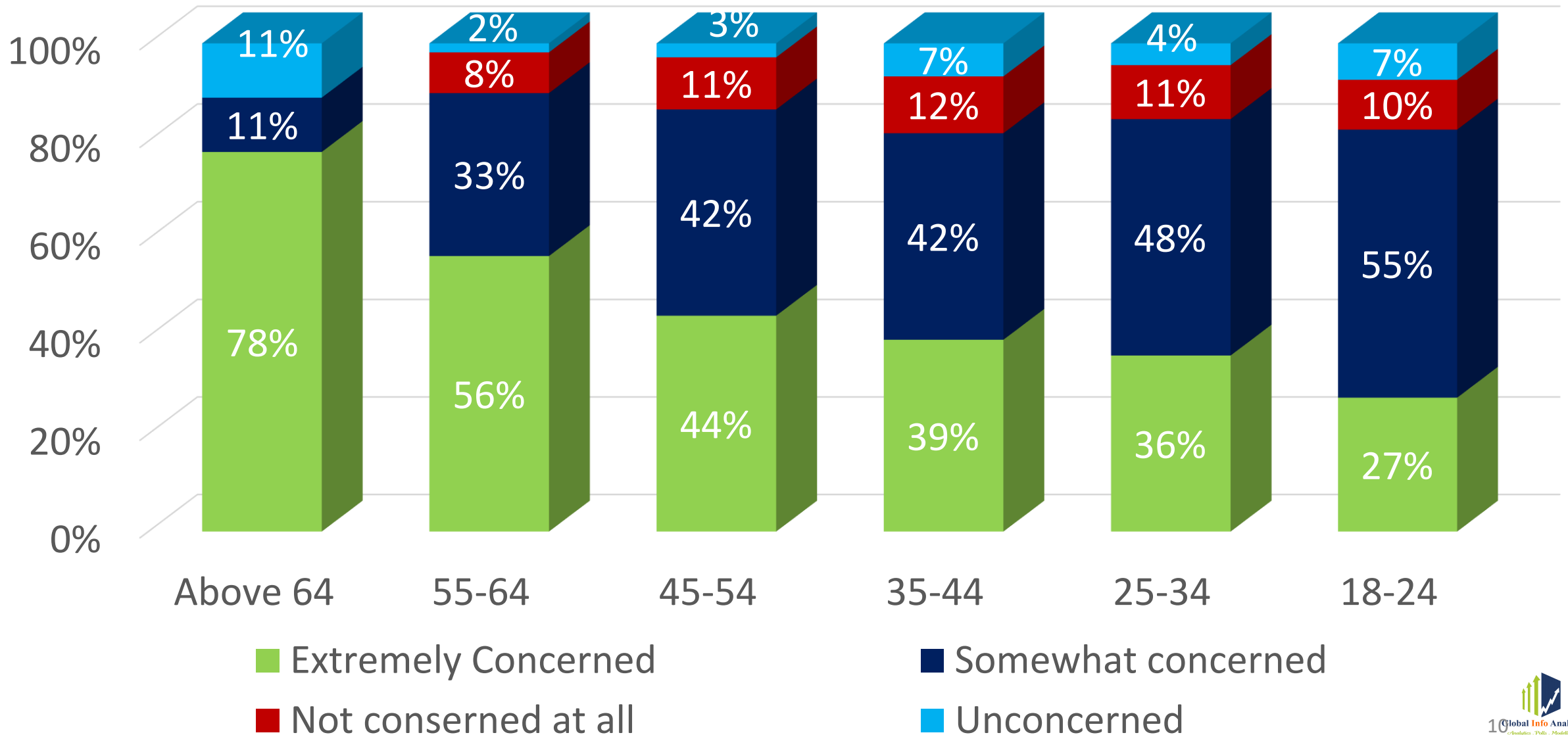

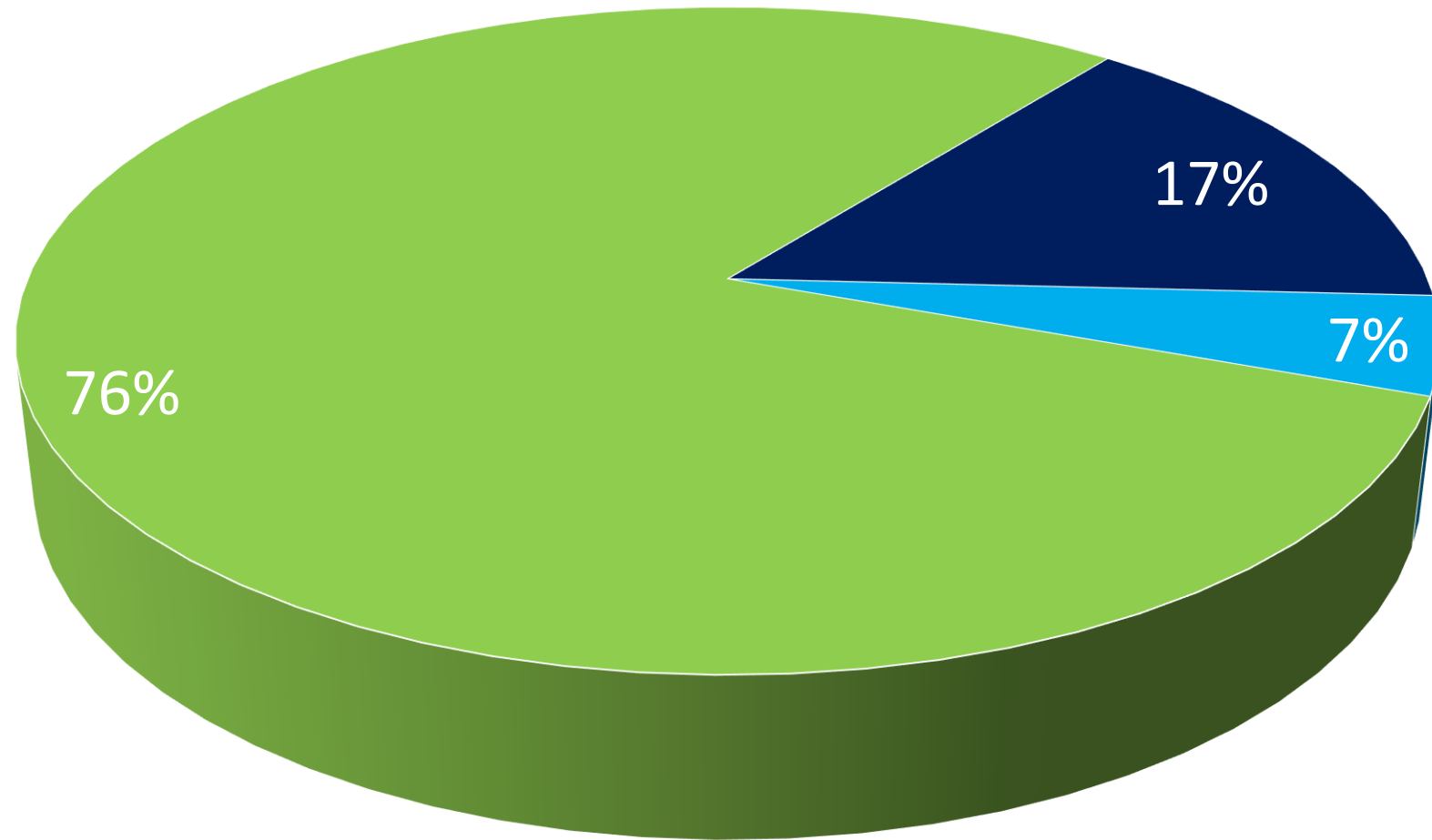

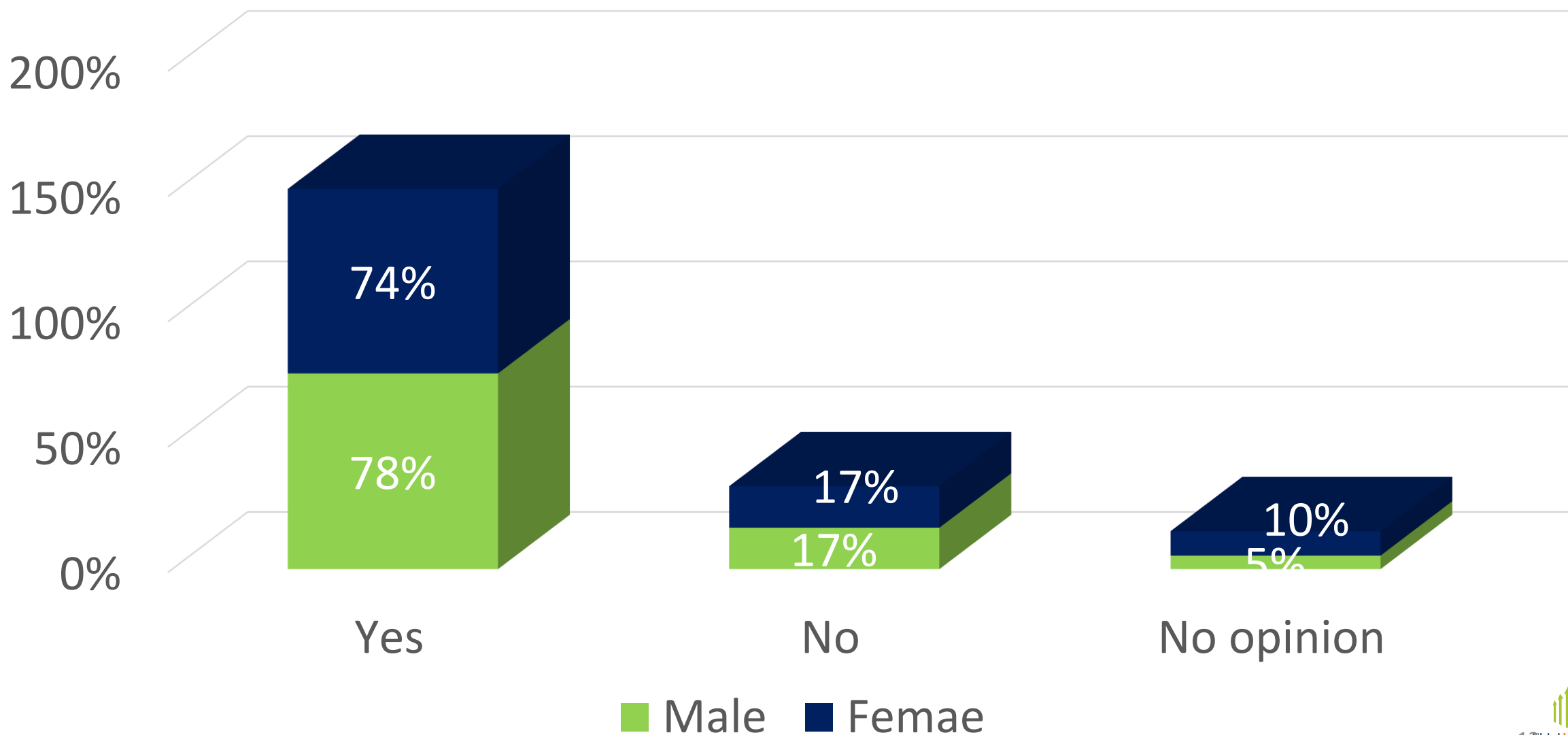

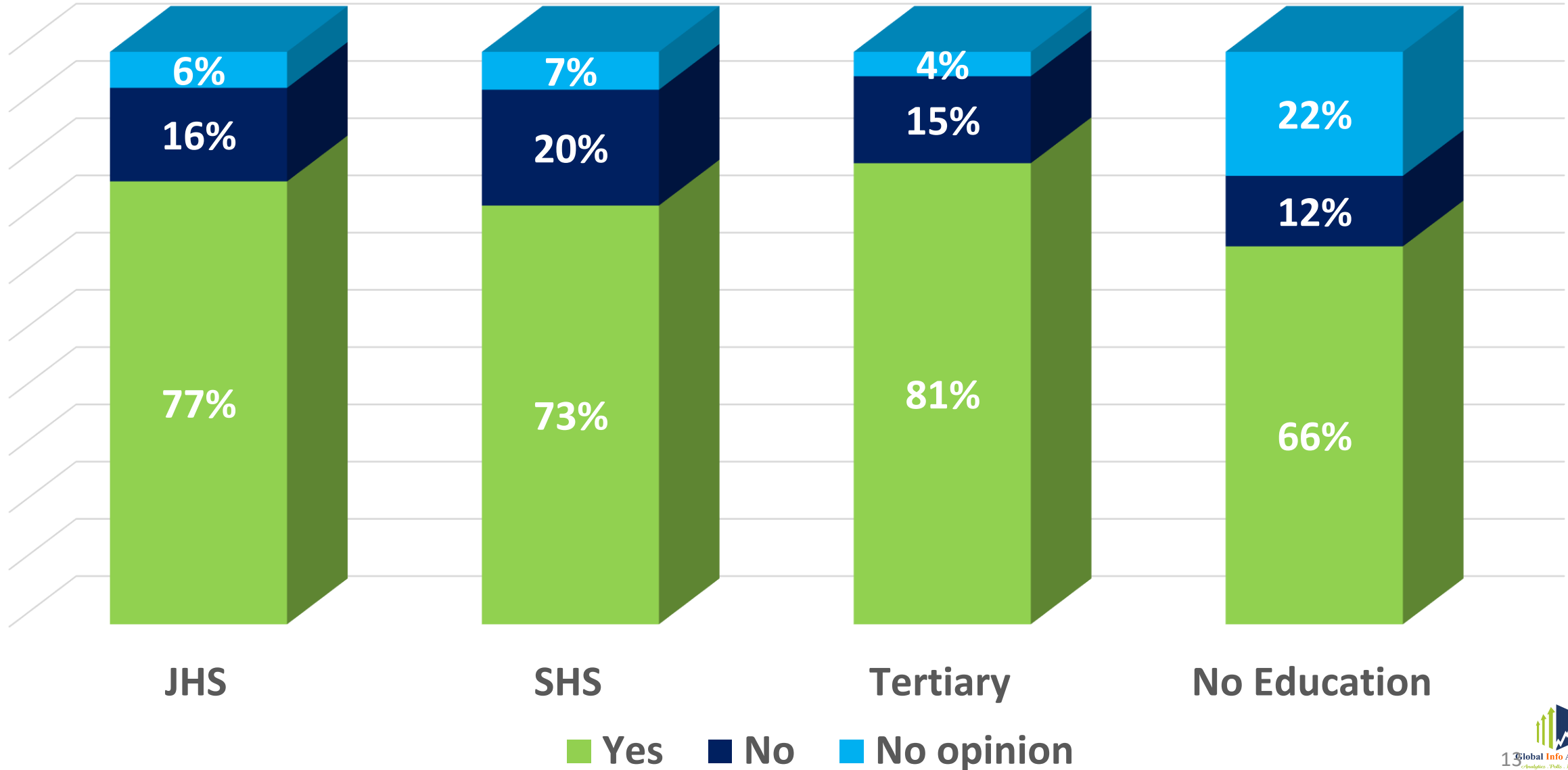

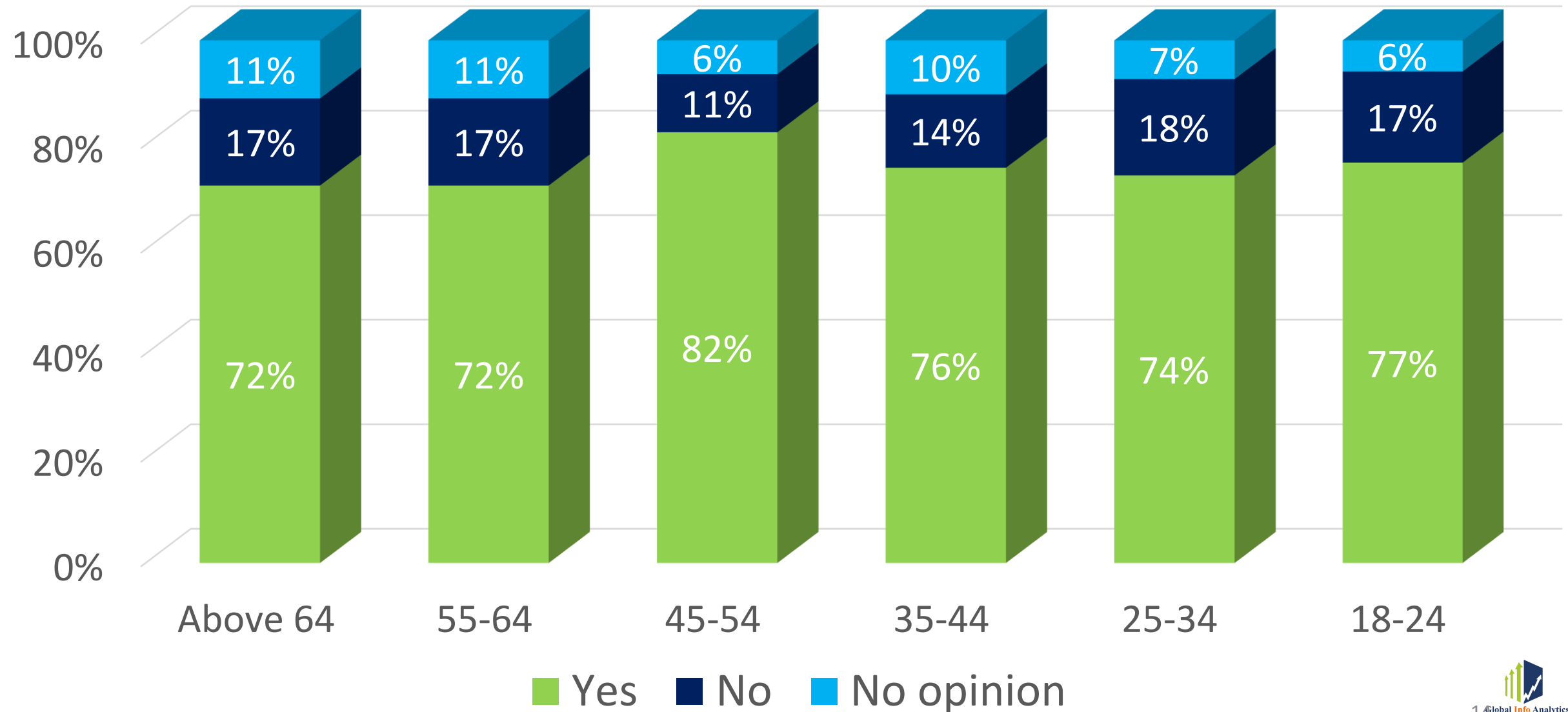

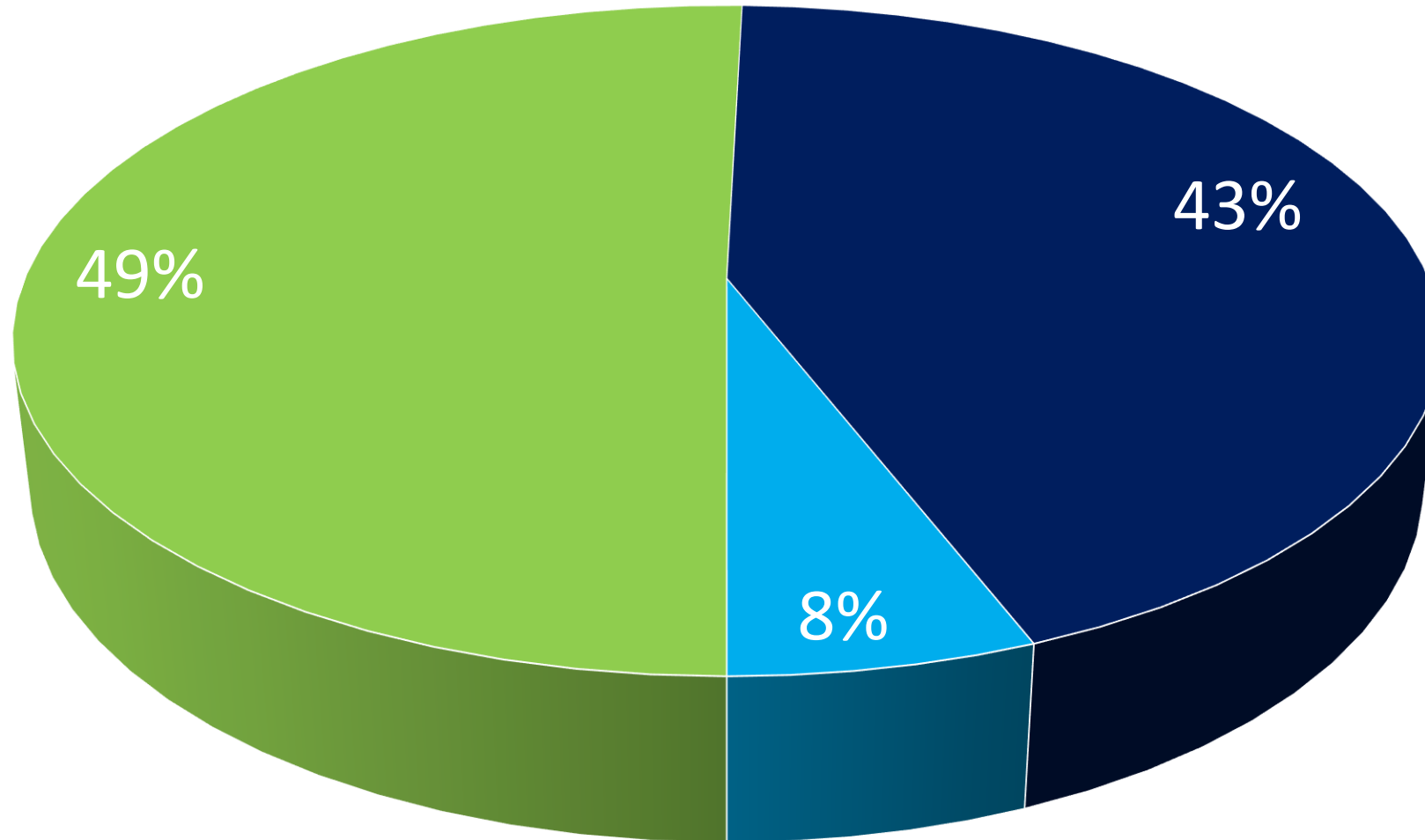

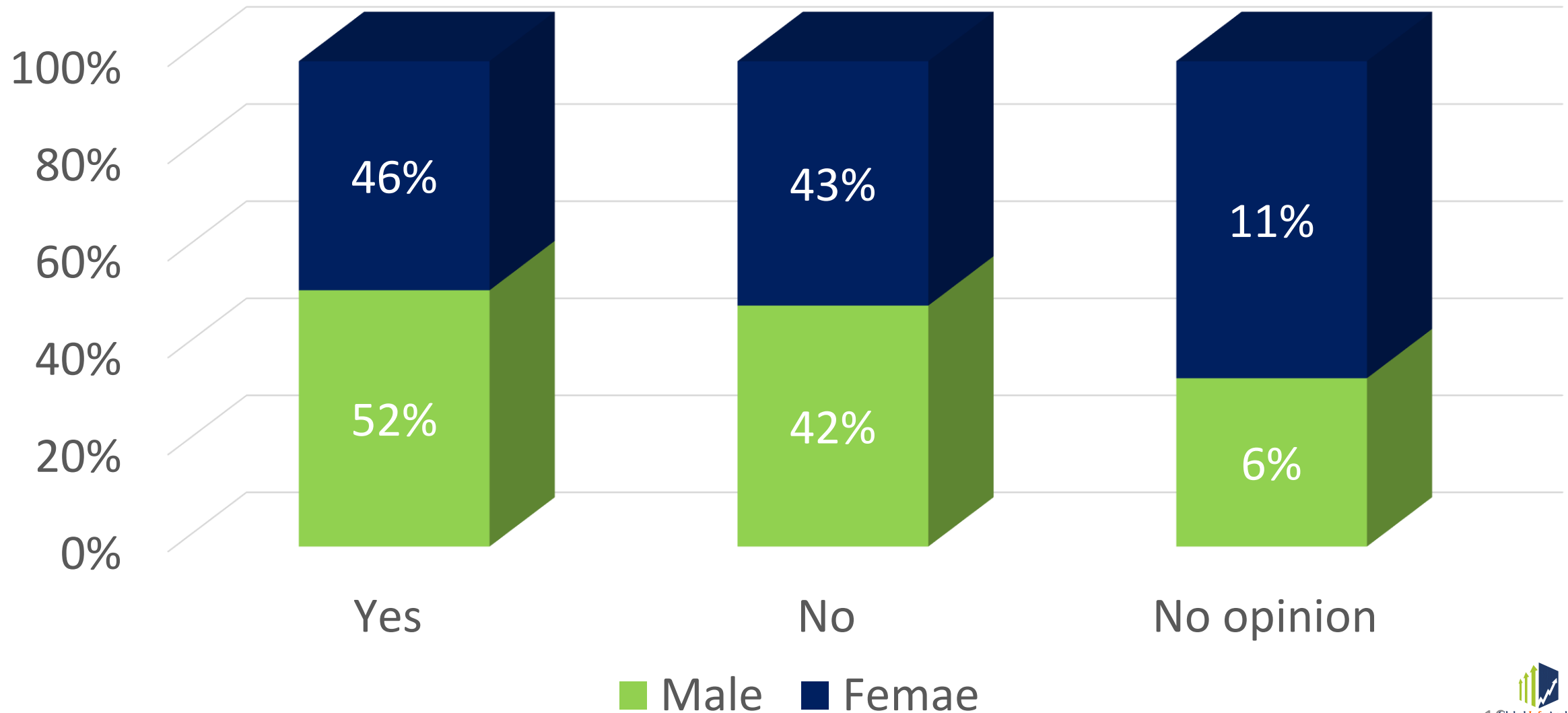

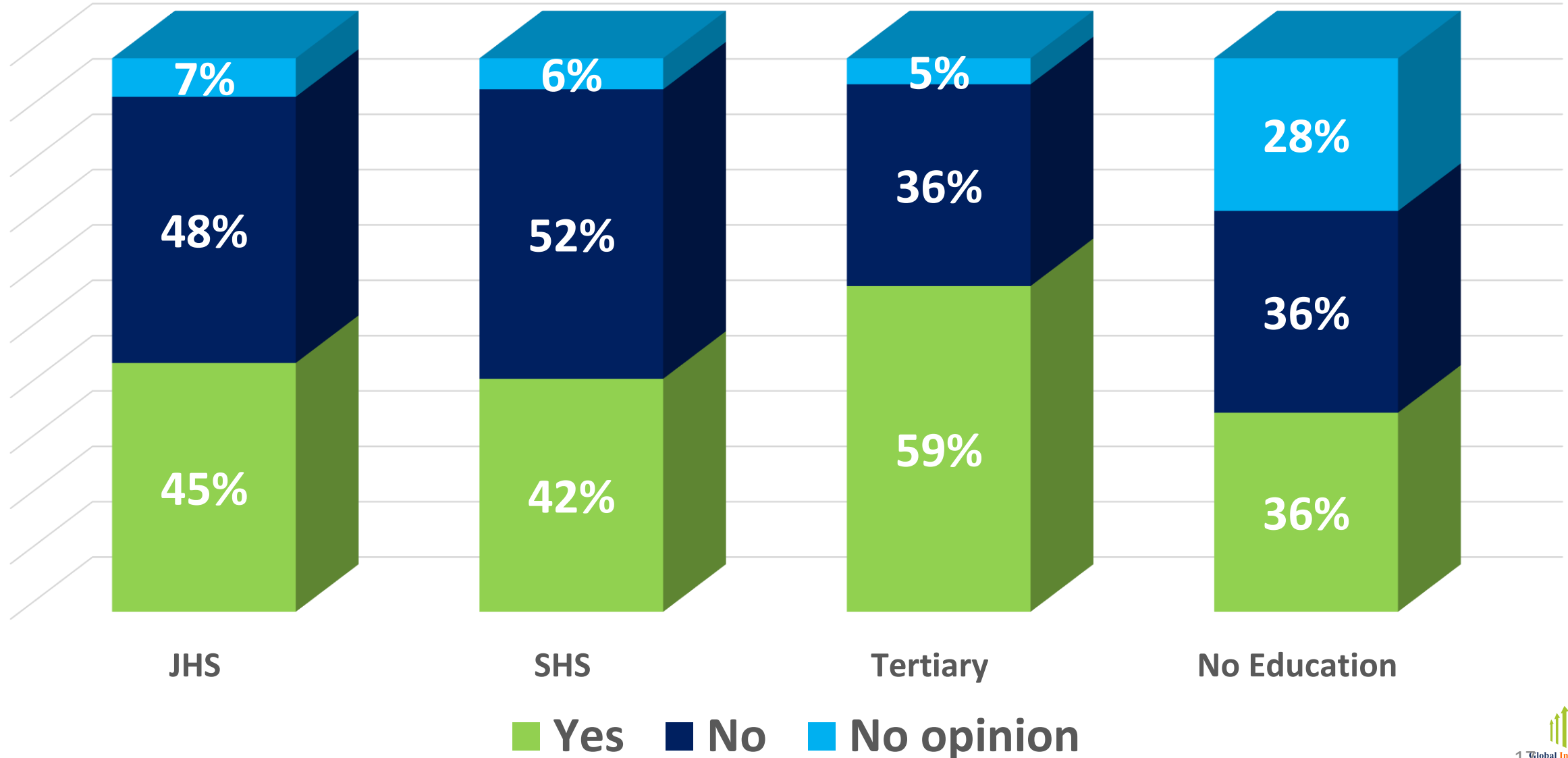

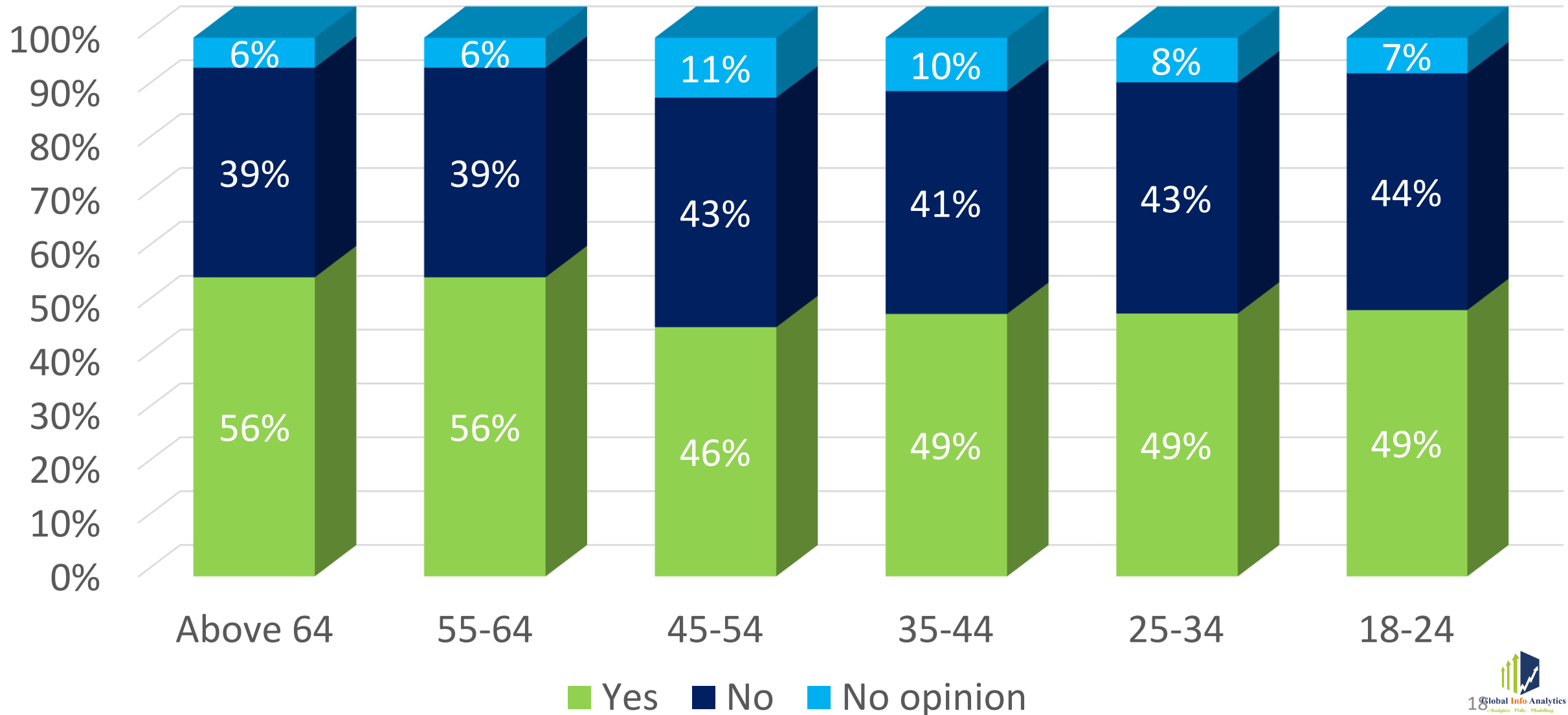

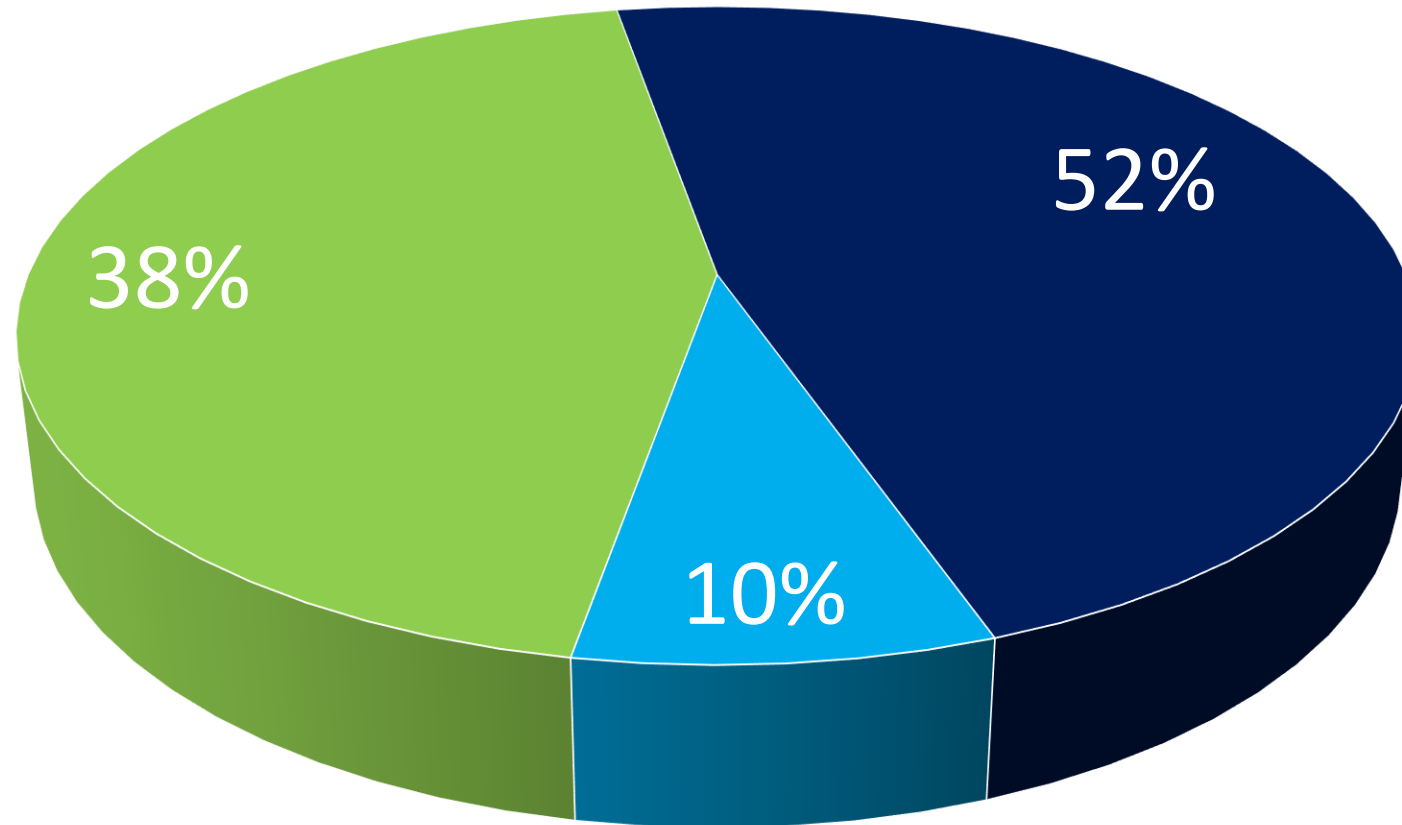
Do you believe that military coups are durable solution to bad governance in Africa? Education Level

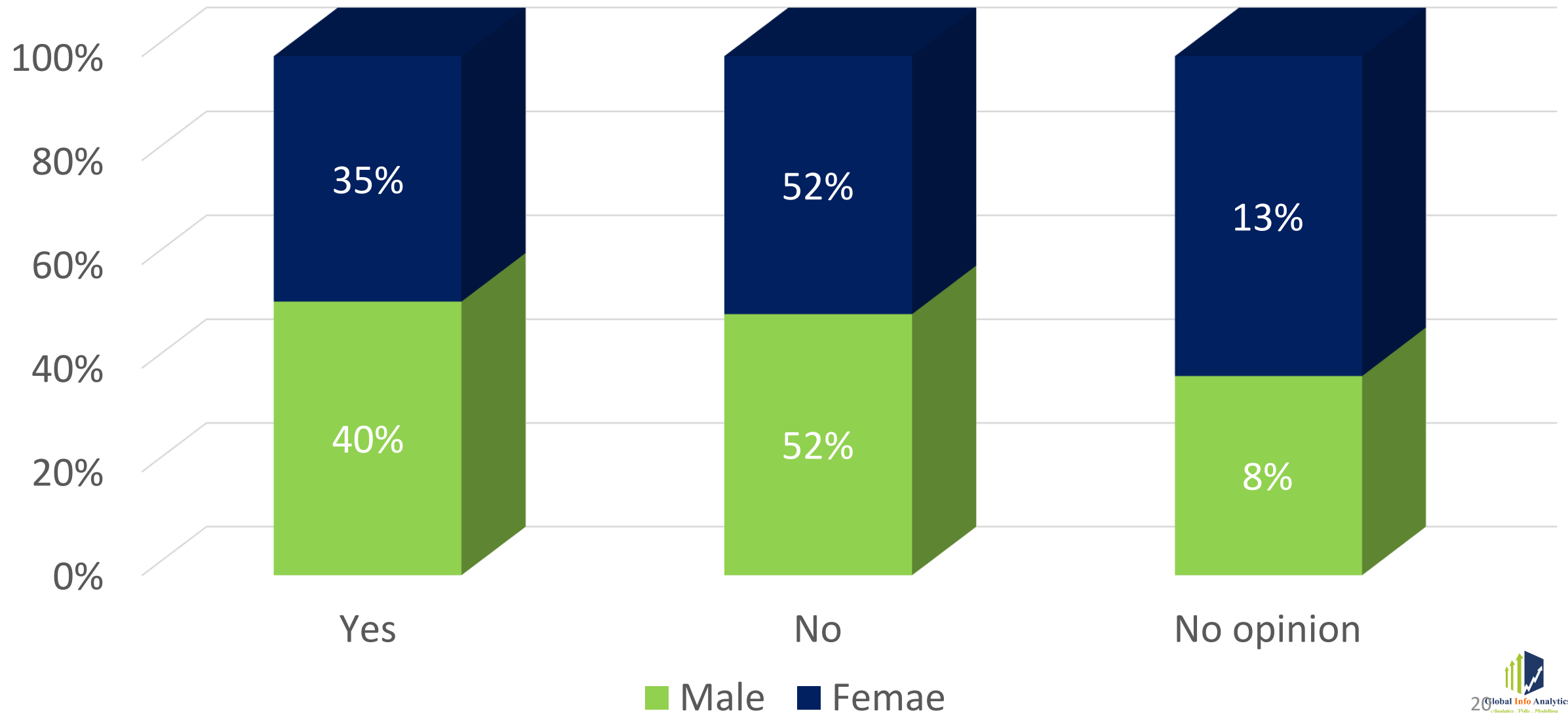

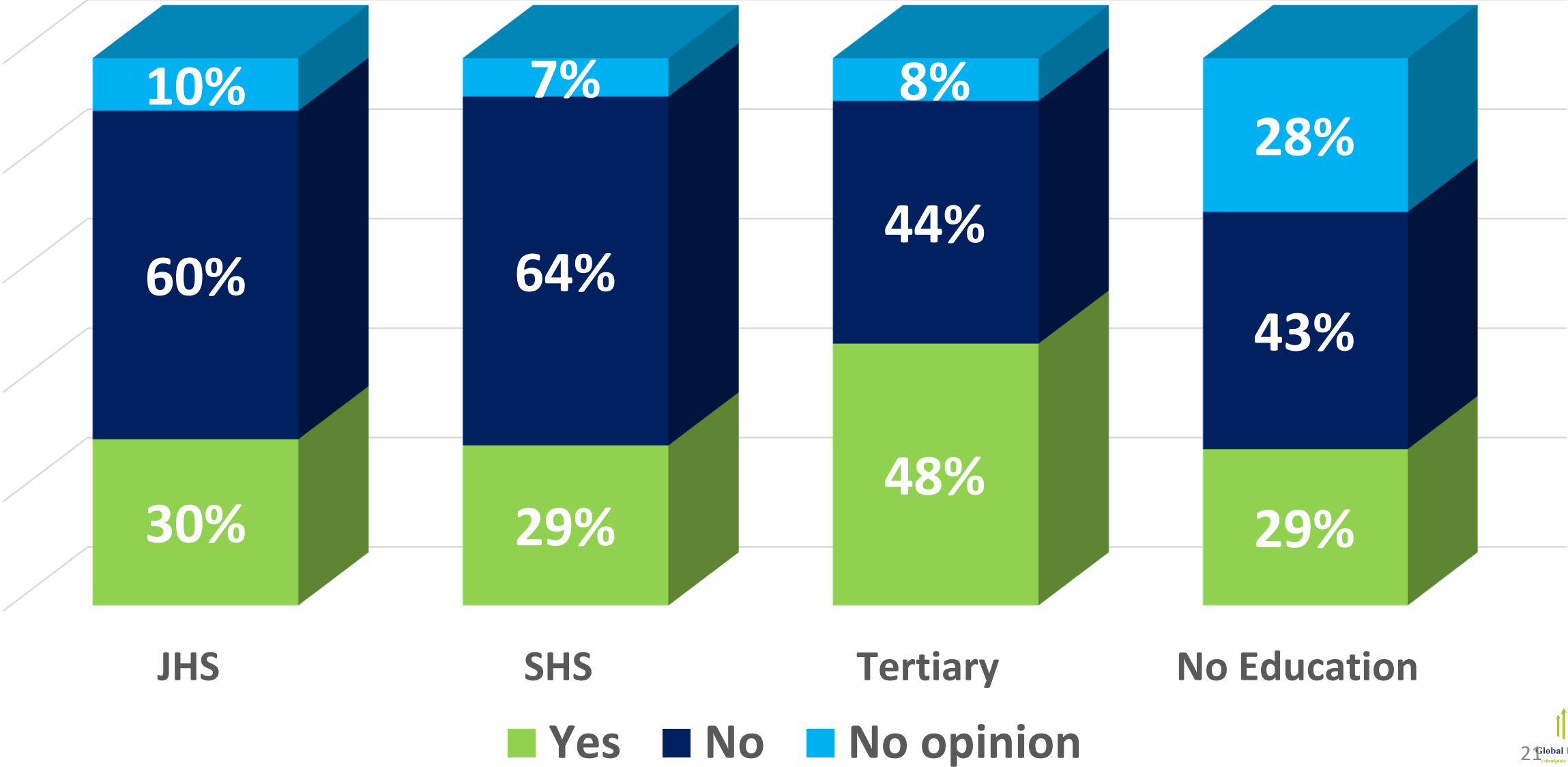

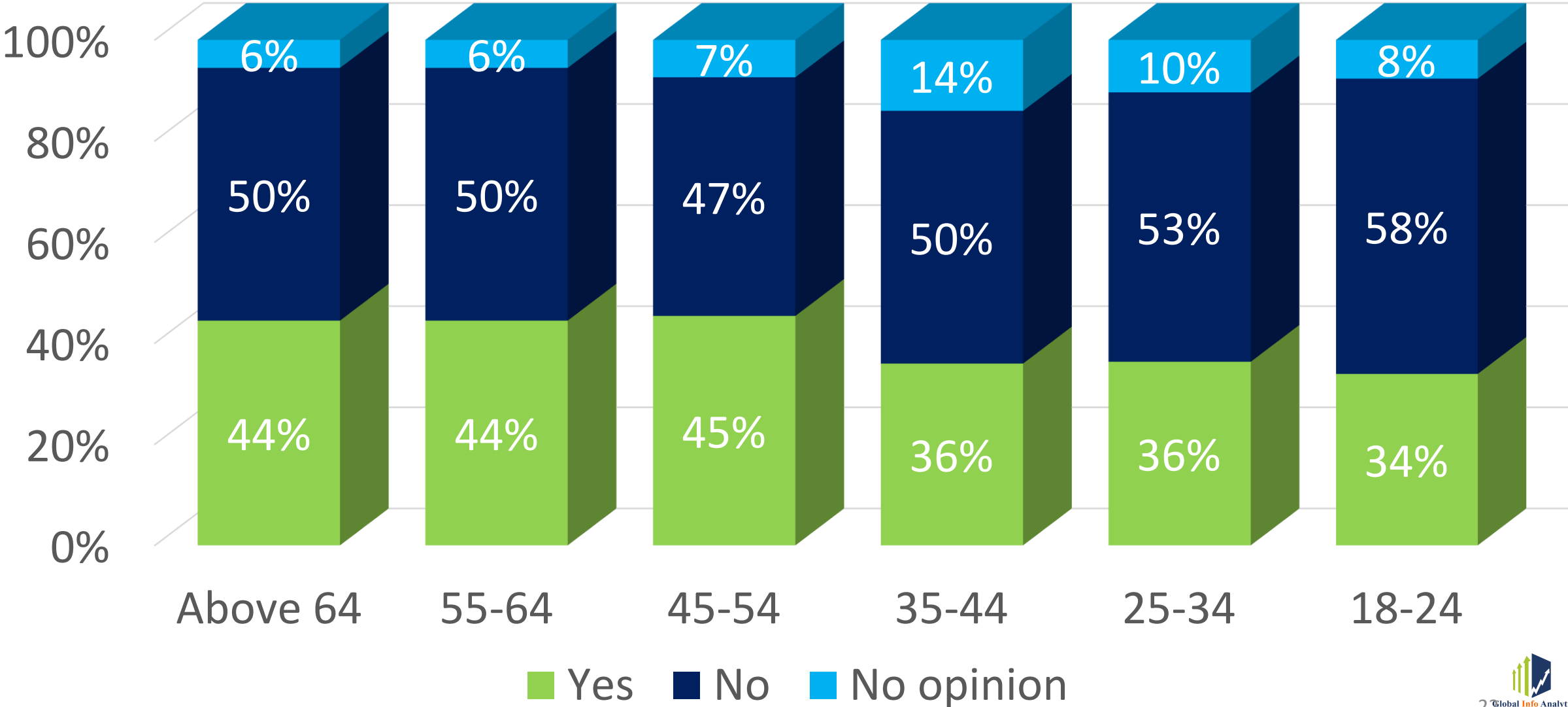
Do you support Ghana taking part in such military action in Niger? Gender



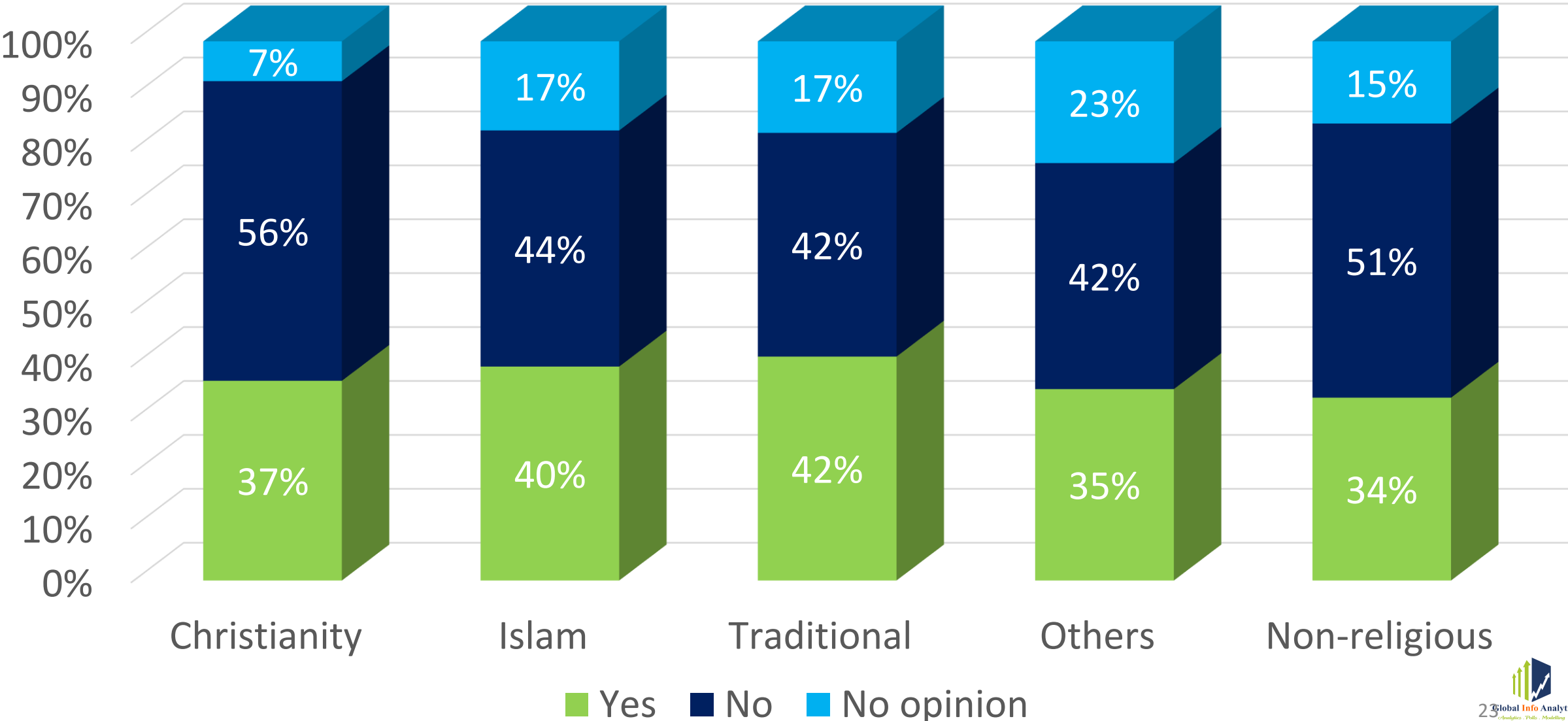
Do you support Ghana taking part in such military action? Education Level



Do you support Ghana taking part in such military action? Education Level- Age Groups

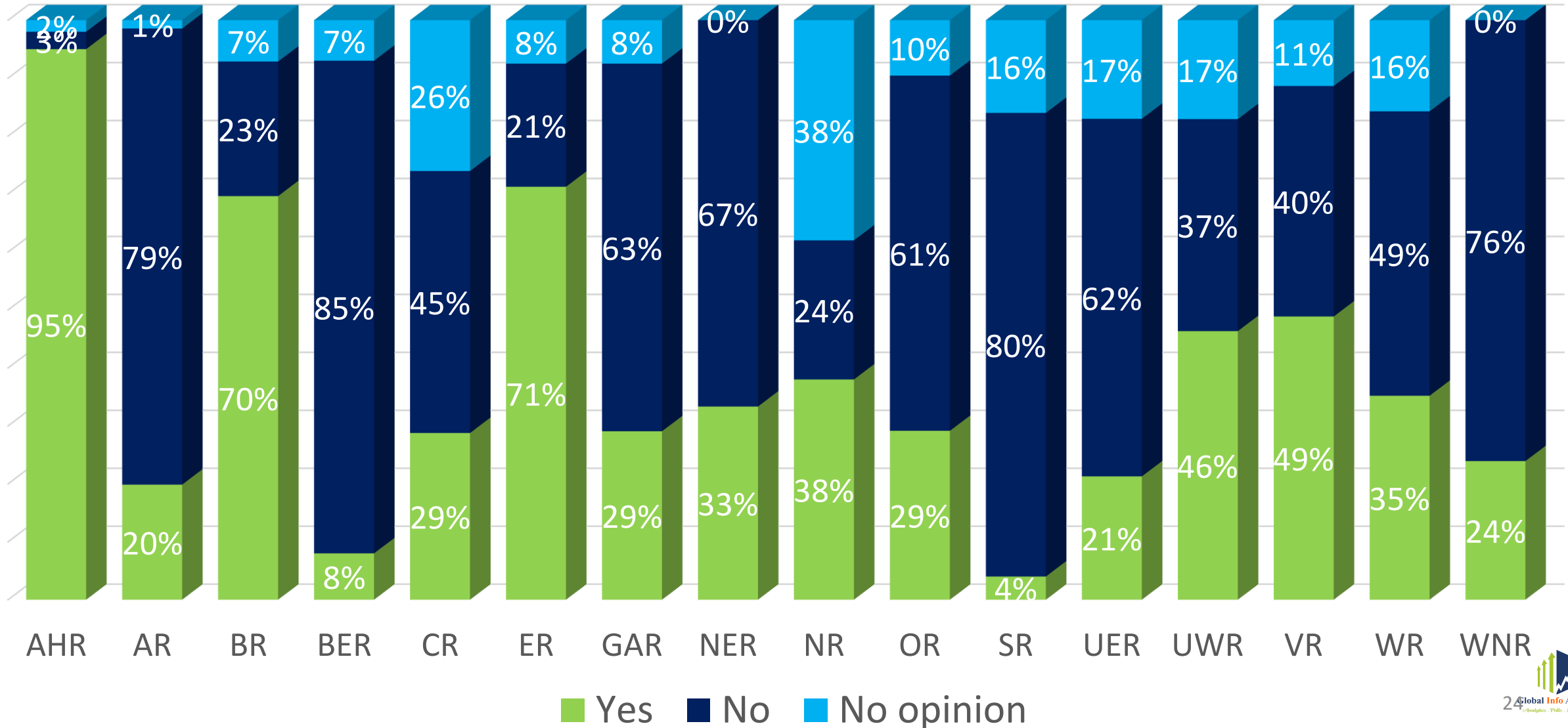

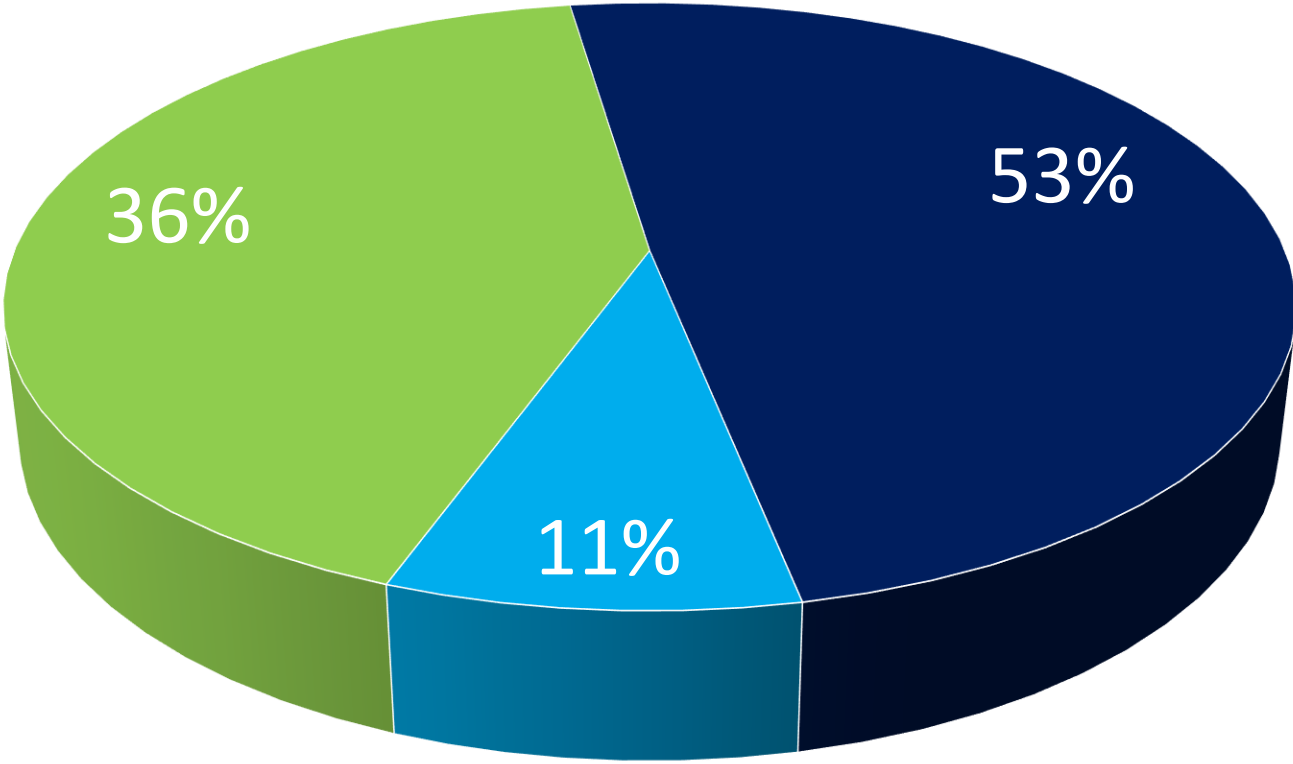

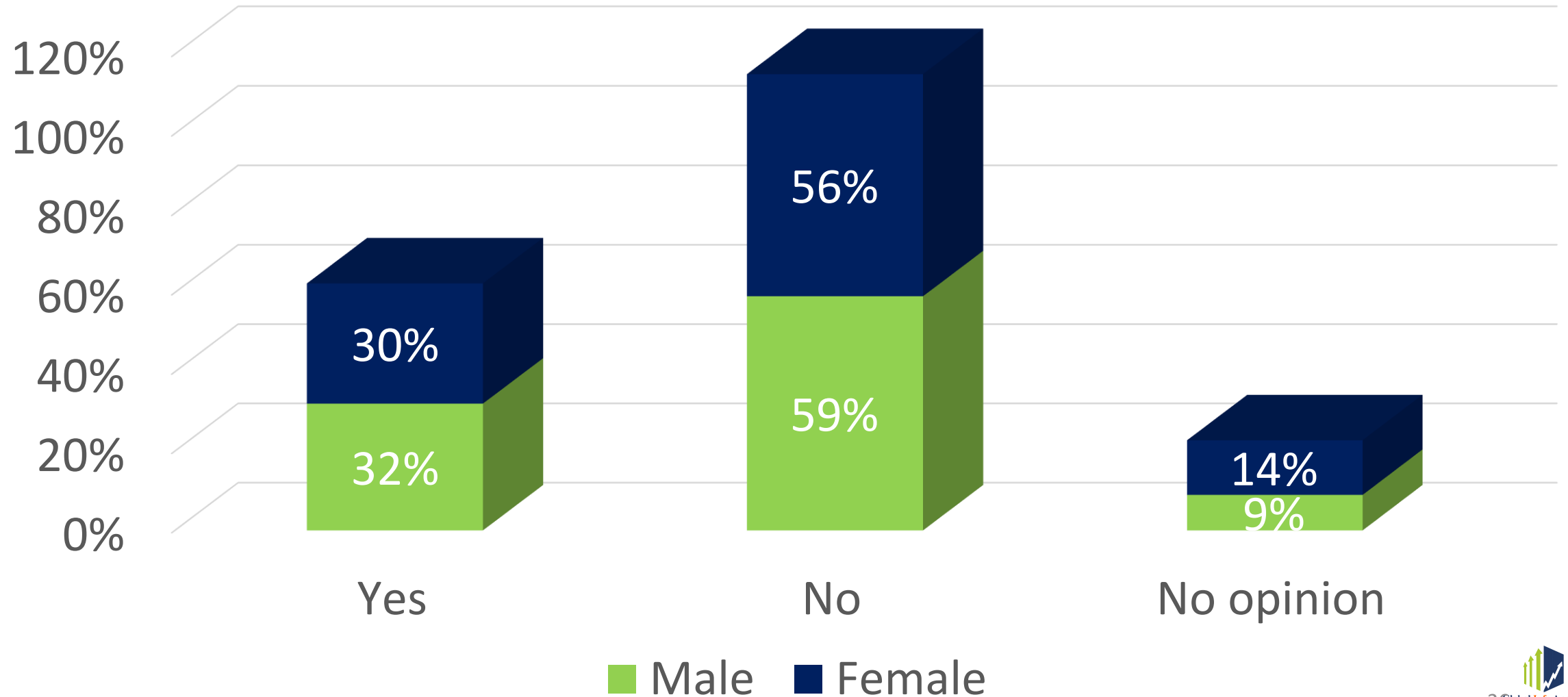


Would you support Ghana's parliament to approve any decision to invade Niger to restore democracy?

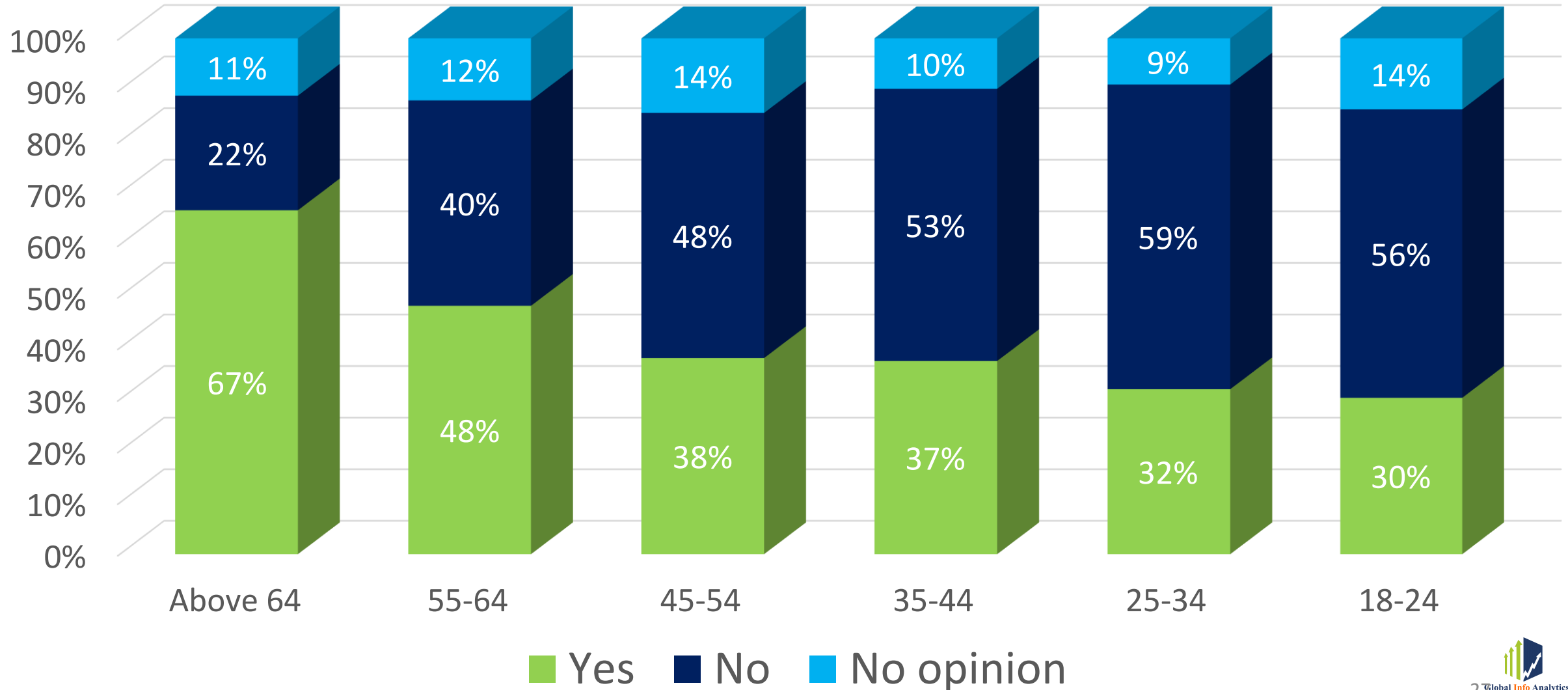

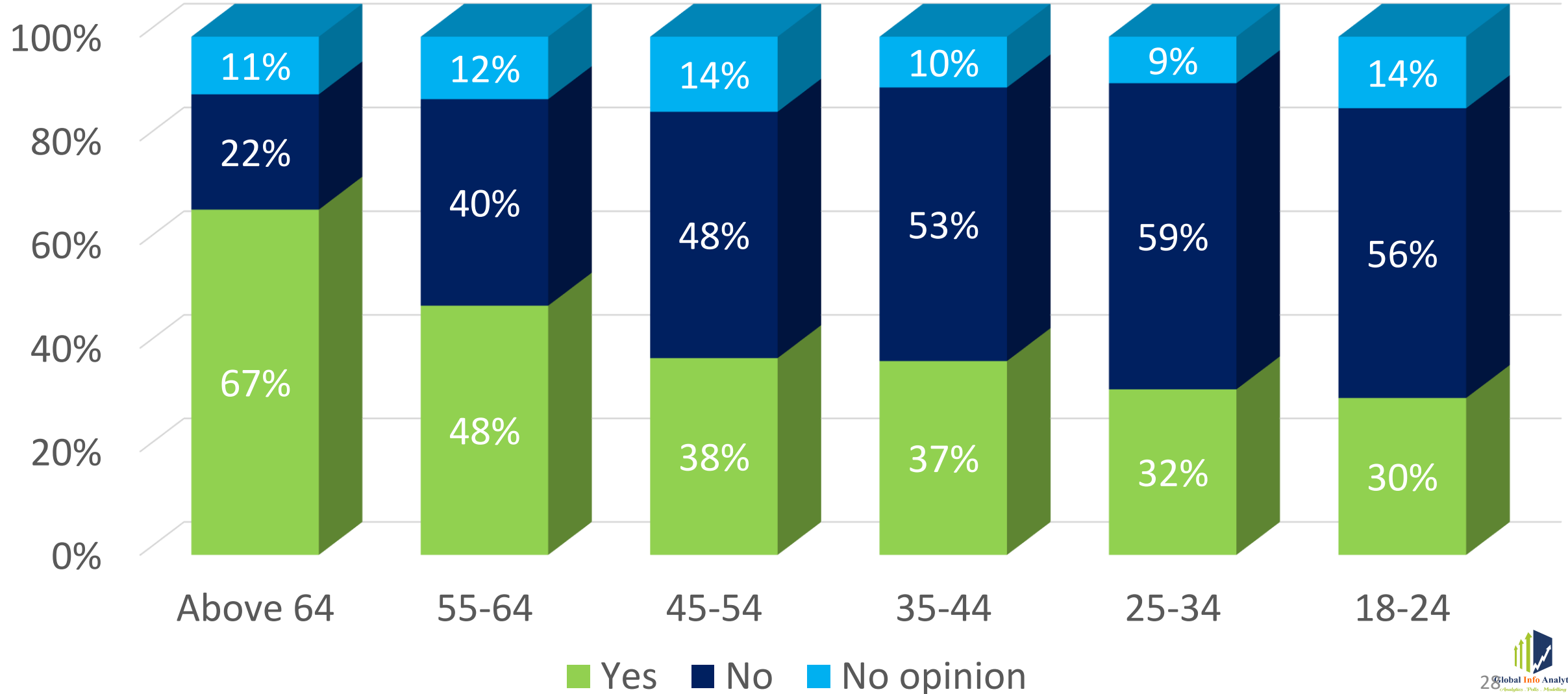
Would you support Ghana's parliament to approve any decision to invade Niger to restore democracy? Gender



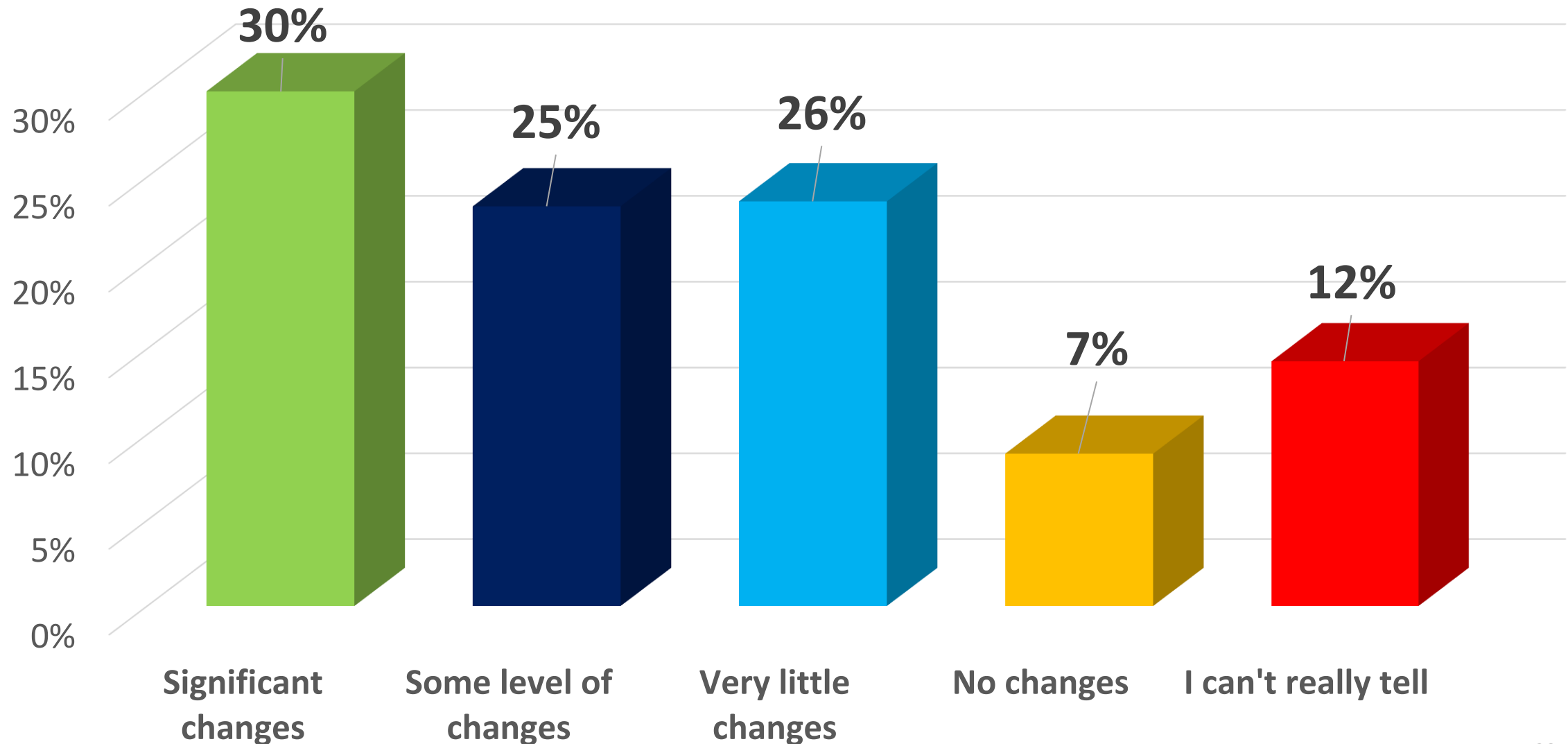

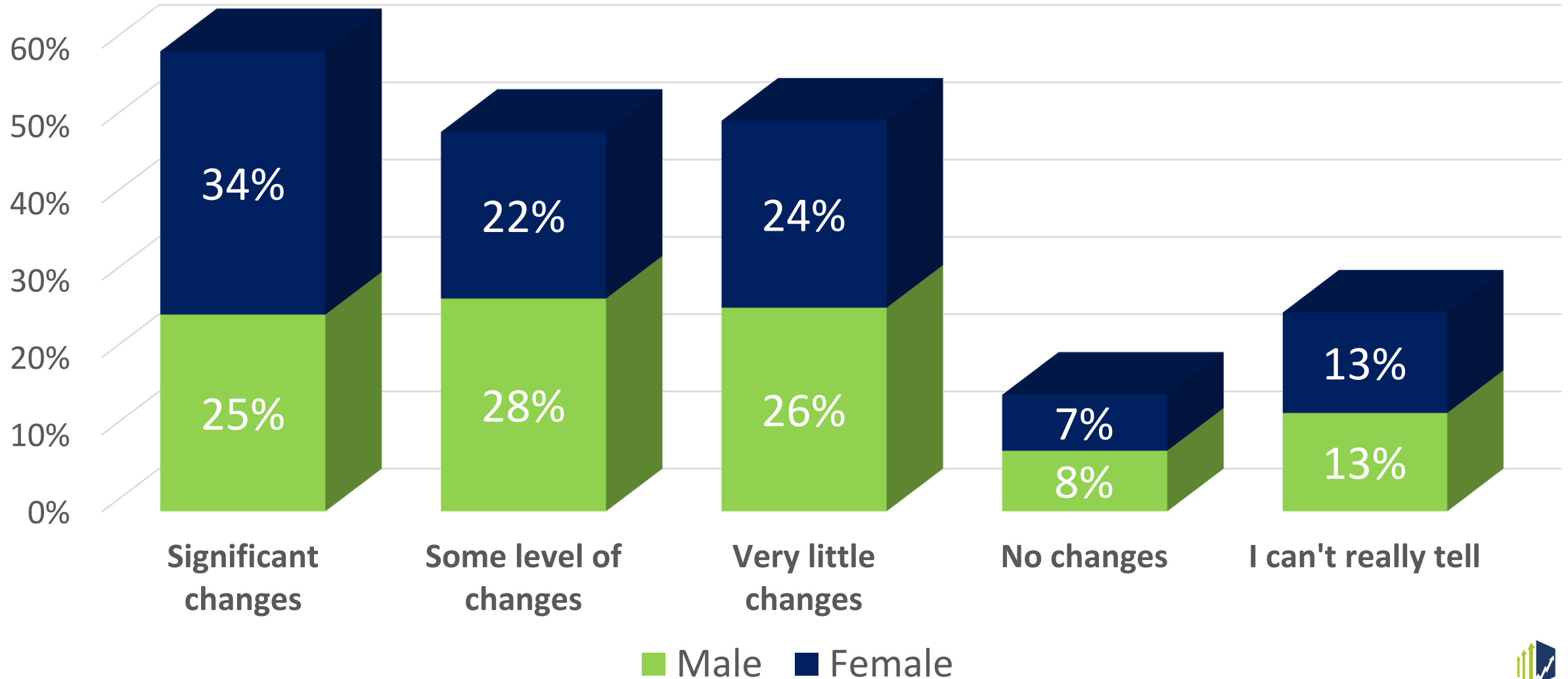
